

GOOD SAMARITAN POLICY OF PI LAMBDA PHI FRATERNITY Approved by the International Executive Council August 26, 2018

Pi Lambda Phi expects its members to act immediately to assist any person experiencing a medical emergency in obtaining immediate and appropriate medical care. If a member of a chapter, colony or affiliated group assists another person in obtaining immediate and appropriate medical care related to the use or consumption of alcohol, drugs, or to another medical emergency, then that member, as well as those who are assisted, will not be subject to individual disciplinary action with respect to the incident. If the member who is assisting a person in distress was a contributing factor to that emergency, their assistance may be considered as a mitigating factor related to violations of organizational policies. To be eligible for potential mitigation, the member will be required to meet in person or by phone with a staff member or alumni volunteer designated by President of the International Fraternity. The decision on mitigation or punishment will be decided by the International Fraternity President or, if necessary the International Executive Council. An individual may benefit from this policy more than once, though repeated use of this Good Samaritan Policy may receive stricter scrutiny.

Pi Lambda Phi expects its chapters, colonies, and affiliated groups to act immediately to assist any person experiencing a medical emergency in obtaining immediate and appropriate medical care. A chapter, colony, or affiliated group that seeks immediate and appropriate medical assistance for a person in need related to the use or consumption of alcohol, drugs, or to another medical emergency, may be eligible for mitigation of charges related to violations of organizational policies. To be eligible for potential mitigation, the chapter will be required to meet in person or by phone with a staff member or alumni volunteer designated by President of the International Fraternity. The decision on mitigation or punishment will be decided by the International Fraternity President. A chapter, colony or affiliated group may benefit from this policy more than once, though repeated use of this Good Samaritan Policy may receive stricter scrutiny.
