

Key Terminology – Pi Lambda Phi University

You will hear the following terms used when talking about Pi Lambda Phi University. To ensure it makes sense to you, please become familiar with the following terms:

LMS (*Learning Management System*) - Software that is used to house content for online learning programs

Pi Lambda Phi University (PLPU) - Pi Lambda Phi's online educational platform that enables continued education for new members and brothers

Learning Plan - A course on PLPU platform (i.e. " Path to Brotherhood, Dynamic Recruitment")

Path to Brotherhood - The continued educational learning plan created to aid in the development of brothers from their new member education period until graduation

Branch - An over-arching section of a learning plan

Module - A specific lesson within a branch of a learning plan

Content - The information provided within a module

Strand - A general area of study (i.e. Football)

Standard - A specific topic within a more general area of study(i.e. offensive line)

Objectives - Specific learning goals or outcome for each module.(i.e. "to teach proper blocking techniques")

Educator - The facilitator for the new member process who guides the development of future Pilam men

Facilitate - The act of guiding conversation and activity to support learning and development

“Round II” - The next phase of the Path of Brotherhood for continuing education after the new member period
